

OTHER TRANSPORT

STUDENT CARS

Students wishing to park their vehicles on campus must obtain the permission of the Senior School Deputy Headmaster. If permitted, a Student Parking Permit will be issued which must be displayed above the vehicle tax disc. Students are to park their vehicles in the Student Car Park located on Reservoir Road unless other arrangements have been agreed with the Senior School Deputy Headmaster.

HAYWARDS HEATH STATION – FRIDAY AFTERNOONS ONLY

Every Friday at 16:45 (12:45 at the end of term/half term), a minibus service is provided to Haywards Heath station. This service is free to all Boarders who require transport to Haywards Heath Station for an onward journey. The service is also available at £2.00 per journey to Day Students. Tickets are available from the Senior School reception. Where chargeable, fares will be added to the student's school bill. Seat priority will be given to Boarders.

SAINSBURY'S SHUTTLE– SUNDAYS ONLY

From Michaelmas term 2011, a minibus shuttle service will be available for Boarders between the College and Sainsbury's supermarket in Haywards Heath. Times and pick-up points will be published at the start of the 2011 academic year.

TAXIS

Students may book taxis for airport runs and other essential journeys by completing an electronic "Taxi Booking Request Form" and emailing it to taxi@ardingly.com. Outside of office hours, taxis may be booked by a Housemaster or Housemistress. Taxi fares are charged to the school bill at the end of each term and may be split between passengers (except journeys below £10.00). All taxis requested via the College are booked with Station Taxis whose drivers are all CRB checked and licensed by Mid Sussex District Council. Students, especially Boarders and those travelling at evenings and weekends, must ensure they have Station Taxis' number (01444 410410) and their Housemaster/Mistress's phone number with them at all times.

BICYCLES

Parents, students and staff are encouraged to cycle to College and secure bicycle points are available at Snow and the Senior School Science Block. Cyclists are advised to wear a helmet and high visibility clothing and, on entering the campus, are requested to dismount and walk to their final destination.

WALKING TO COLLEGE

There is a pavement along College Road from Ardingly Village to Ardingly College. Pedestrians are advised to cross the road at one of the three crossing points provided and are requested not to walk through the main vehicle entrance. The walk from Ardingly Village to the College takes approximately 10-15 minutes.

METROBUS

Metrobus services 82 and 682 between Crawley and Haywards Heath stop at Hapstead Hall, Ardingly. Unfortunately the morning service arrives too late for the College's start time but the afternoon service may be of interest. Please see www.metrobus.co.uk for further information.
